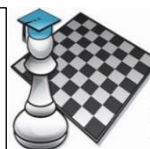

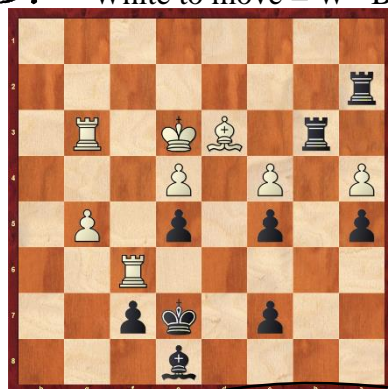
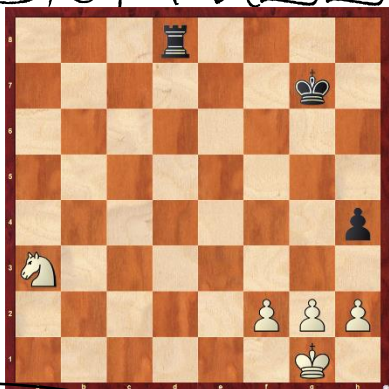

TACTICAL TIPS + TRICKS: General Tips 4: Preparing for Games With A Computer

Hi guys, one thing you learn the more you play chess, is the important role chess computers have to play! That is, there is no better tool to help us learn different openings and defences. For, we can see what the computer plays at the start and follow its sequence of moves through, given particular opponent responses. We can also input our own games (after we play them of course!), and see what the computer would have played in tricky situations. Chess players of all strengths use computers to learn in this way. Certain chess computers are also good to practice the various chess tactics we talk about in class, with their series of inbuilt pins, forks and skewer puzzles to boot! So, what are you waiting for?
