## TACTICAL TIPS + TRICKS:

Trading Queens off Early #3 The Lion's Yawn Variations

Hi guys. Last time we looked at the moves e4, d6, d4, Nf6, Nc3, e5, dxe5, dxe5, Qxd8, Kxd8 in the lion's yawn. But how do we continue as black? There are two main plans here for white. These are to play Bishop to c4, or play bishop to g5 here. After bishop to c4 (Bc4), white attacks our f7 pawn. The safest way to defend is to go bishop to e6 (Be6), immediately challenging white's bishop. And after Bishop takes bishop (on e6), black should take back with the f pawn, continuing with the plan of moving Nc6, Bd6 and Ke7 (with full development and all important central control). If white plays Bg5 (the second option above), Be6, Nd7, c6 and Kc7 also give a full centre to black. For a further example of option 1, see the Magic Mini 😝 😉
