Chess Players in Focus 3#:

TACTICAL TIPS + TRICKS: Bent Larsen (1935-2010)- See Magic Mini

Hi everyone. For this RNF I thought we'd look at another of the most famous chess players in history never to become a World Champion, the Danish Chess Grandmaster and six time Danish Champion (plus a candidate for the World Chess Championship on four occasions) Bent Larsen. Now, Larsen himself had multiple wins over 7 World Chess Champions in his career, including Bobby Fischer. Primarily known for his unorthodox play, the Larsen attack (which is a way to start a game for White/called an opening) starts 1. pawn to b3 with the plan of 2. Bishop to b2. This was named after Larsen himself, who popularized it. Such a style of attack plays on the idea that you don't have to have pawns in the center necessarily to control it- you can control it from long range. This is very much what we can learn from Bent Larsen and his games. And also, that playing this way surprised many an opponent.


