
TACTICAL TIPS + TRICKS: Vera Menchik (1906-1944)- See Magic Mini

Hi everyone. For this RNF I thought we'd take a look at the chess ideas and games of the first ever Woman's World Chess Champion, Vera Menchik. Vera Menchik was the Woman's World Chess Champion from 1927 up until 1944, defending her title the most of all time (eight times). What we can learn from her games is the idea that we want to play very carefully and just try to avoid any complications the opponent might throw at us. That is, so that we can try and reach favorable and even completely winning endgame positions for us. This style of chess aims to reduce risk in as much as possible and is quite effective. Moreover, Vera Menchik, when she was playing, was also known for her ability to remain calm over the board, even when her opponents were attacking her, allowing her to see through such attacks a lot easier. Really strong players tend to do that from experience (See Magic
