## TACTICAL

 Hi guys. For this newsletter, I thought we'd look at the useful theme of "opening up files and diagonals." This is because, our strongest long-range pieces move along these lines, (our Queens, Rooks and Bishops). So, it is important to give our best pieces AS MUCH SPACE AS POSSIBLE, on the ranks [lines going across the board], files [lines going up and down the board] and diagonals [lines going diagonally] of the chess board. In other words, these lines are actually our "highways into the opponent's camp". Finally, what's better than having one piece on an open line? Having two- or even three. That is, doubling or tripling up our pieces to take complete control over the line in question. This is a powerful idea known as a BATTERY. It literally can be as simple as
