Hi everyone. For this RNF, I thought we should look at one of the greatest American chess players (and indeed, one of the best chess players ever, never to become World Champion), Samuel Reshevsky 1911-1992. Reshevsky himself was a chess prodigy (see the picture below of him as a junior beating several masters at the same time going from board to board). He was also a Grandmaster and 8-time US Champion-tying with the great Bobby Fischer for this record. What we can learn from Reshevsky's playing style and his games is his 100% clear focus on positional play. That is, even though he was extremely good at tactical chess too, Reshevsky's games showed the importance of setting such tactics up in the first place. Forks, pins, skewers etc can't happen

unless our pieces have a good <u>position</u> with In each position find the best move/moves.
