### "Rarest of the Rare #3" Caro Kann- 'Kane' Variation

Do practice the ideas:)

Hi everyone. For this newsletter, let's look at the interesting idea (for White), against the Caro Kann, known as the Caro-Kann, Kane Variation. This is, where the idea is, to put a frustrating knight (for the opponent) on the square g5 and eye all sorts of tricks and tactics against the weak f7 square. Remember, the f7 square is the weakest square on the chessboard at the start of the game as it is only guarded by the King! The Caro Kann- Kane Variation starts with 1. White pawn to e4, Black replies Pawn to c6-(this is the Caro Kann). But now, after the usual follow up moves, 2. White Knight to c3, Black Pawn to d5, 3. White Knight to f3, Black takes on e4, 4. White captures back with the Knight, Black goes Knight to f6, and, here, after 5. Knight e to g5 from White we
