## TACTICAL TIPS + TRICKS: "Interesting Ideas 3"

It's hippo-possible not to find hippo chess jokes funny! XD The Old Hippo- see magic mini

Hi everybody. For this edition of RNF- RNF 123, I thought we would look at the super interesting and super rare idea called "the old hippo". Now there is a hippopotamus defence in chess generally, (which is a way to start the game for Black!). Basically, you bring out your Bishops to b7 and g7, and have pawns on e6, d6, a6, b6 and h6 and g6. Your knights then come out to e7 and d7. This setup could be called the "Modern hippo". The "Old Hippo" is something different again though. This is an older idea, where you move all your pawns up one square (except the side pawns- so not you're A pawn or H pawn). Then you develop your knights

to f2 and c2 (f7 and c7 for Black), by going knight h3 to f2 etc and on the other side. Your Bishops go on g2 and b2 and you castle +


