Magic Mini has Trap + NM Dana Mackenzie Game

Hi everyone. Your coach [supercoach] has done some reading and preparing over the last holidays and has found some quite interesting and instructive ideas indeed to teach you! That is, from the extremely vast corners of the chess world! The first of these ideas is the really rare gambit for White, called the Bryntse Gambit! Now, the Bryntse Ganbit is a pattern at the start that gives up your Queen no less- after the moves, 1. e4 c5 2. f4 d5 3. Nf3!? dxe4 4. Ng5 Nf6 5. Bc4 (putting pressure on f7) Bg4 and 6. Qxg4?! Nxg4, with 7. Bxf7+ Kd7 & 8. Be6+ Kc6 and 9. Bxg4. White loses their Queen for two pieces, but draws out Black's King into the center, and attempts to establish a strong bind over the position. You don't have to play this, but it's another useful attacking

International Master with + nearly a Grandmaster. Helps boost tactics

Find the best move/moves.



Here, Black's pawns are going up the page. How can **Black** really make use of both their Bishops to trap White's King on a3 to mate or win material?

1. e4 c5	18. Be2 Kc7
2. f4 d5	19. b3 Rd8
3. Nf3 dxe4	20. Nc4 Nd5
4. Ng5 Nf6	21. Bb2 Nb6
5. Bc4 Bg4	22. Be5+! Kc8
6. Qxg4 Nxg4	23. Nxb6+ axb6
7. Bxf7+ Kd7	24. Ba6+! Kd7
8. Be6+ Kc6	25. Bb5+ 1-0

Final Position/Analysis- NM Dana Mackenzie 2175 v. Bryce Yeh 2009

1. Try not open files as White
2. Try swap 1 knight for a Bishop
3. Try reduce space of Black Queen
4. Try keep bind over early material
5. Try and be patient. Wait for opp.
