Lessons Learnt #1" **AUTOMATIC MOVES**

One of the most important ideas in all of chess actually. That is, learning from your own experiences playing. Recently, in one of my own tournament games from this year, I was reminded of the age old key idea: "one should try not play automatic moves. 
