## TACTICAL TIPS + TRICKS: IDEAS TO KNOW IN GAMES #3 USING THE BISHOP PAIR

Hi guys. Often games can be won or lost by what's called piece imbalances- which means you have different pieces than your opponent. But what if yours and your opponent's pieces are worth the same points- like knights and bishops. What if you have a knight and your opponent has a bishop or vice versa. Both pieces are worth 3 points, so how do we know which piece is better. Normally this question comes down to how much space the pieces in question have. But usually if you have two bishops that's the best minor piece pairing there is (minor pieces are Knights + Bishops, major pieces are Queens + Rooks). Two Bishops can sweep the board, they cover both colours and are much faster than knights in moving around. When there's less pieces (in the
