# TACTICAL TIPS + TRICKS:

## **IDEAS TO KNOW IN GAMES #4** ACTIVE ROOKS IN THE ENDING

Hi everybody. Building up our experience in chess, one of the best ways to do this is to look at Rook endgames. I think the reason for this is Rook endgames come up all the time and they're extremely practical. That is, Rook endgames are often won by the side who has the more active Rook. Rooks can control lines (files and ranks). A good rule of thumb is as White, try to get your Rooks to the 7th rank in the endgame to attack opponent's pawns and hopefully trap your opponent's King. As Black, try to get your Rooks to the 2nd rank to do this. Often, even if you're down one or two pawns, if you have super active rooks while your opponent's rooks are passively defending pawns, this can be a big advantage. As always, the best way to learn rook endings

is to practice them  $\circ$ 


