TACTICAL TIPS + TRICKS:

Attacking Ideas In Chess #1 **Targeting the F2 and F7 Pawns**

Hi guys. We know that when we play chess we want to make things as easy as possible for ourselves to win. Sometimes we have to win a game in a hard (or difficult) way that's true, but generally the simpler we make things for us the better. And this goes especially for attacking chess too. When we attack, as a starting point, we want to work out where we will attack/ or the opponent's weakest points. These can be critical squares (or pieces) that aren't defended a lot (or if at all). In other words we don't want to attack something that's defended one million times when we have a choice to attack a piece that's poorly defended in comparison. At the start of the game these weak squares are f7 (for Black) and f2 (for White). Such squares are only




