TACTICAL TIPS + TRICKS: Attacking ideas in Circss #2 Get every piece doing something ©

Hi guys. When we play chess, naturally, we want to get all of our pieces doing something. It's kind of like each piece is part of a team. If one side just uses their knights only for the whole game when the other side brings out all of their pieces, the 2 knights will quickly get overwhelmed when faced with the far greater numbers. Chess, we know, is a numbers game. But this goes for all parts of the game. That is, from the opening, to the middlegame and the endgame. The most successful mini games/early attacks at the start come from the opponent not bringing out their pieces in the opening. While, the more pieces attacking the opponent's castled Kingside the better (in the middlegame). And, in the endgame, having greater numbers of pawns on the


