### Famous Chess Players in History #3

### Rashid Nezhmetdinov 1912-1974 😊

Hi guys. For this RNF I thought it would be good and interesting to talk about one of the most feared attacking chess players of all time, so much so that he was actually given the nickname of "No Reverse Gear", that is Rashid Nezhmetdinov. In fact, Super Coach himself has noticed that a lot of strong juniors in fact go all out to attack first and defend later. Defence undeniably plays a big role in a chess game and the more experience we get the more we come to appreciate this. But an all-out attacking style is to be encouraged too, as this helps us boost our tactics. The key is finding the right balance. And Nezhmetdinov earned his International Master title, and became five-time Russian Champion during his career by undeniably finding the right balance.

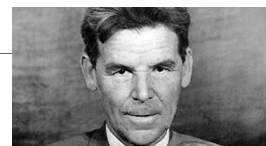
