This tournament is run as an individual event. The winning school is determined by adding the 4 highest scorers from each school. **Numbers are strictly limited. Each school is limited to a maximum of 10 players per Division.** There is no need to rank them by ability, or to assign teams.

This tournament is a 7-round 'Swiss' competition. This means that all players play 7 games and no one is 'knocked out' of the tournament.

TIME LIMIT

Chess clocks will be used in this event. There will be a short demonstration on the use of chess clocks before the start of the tournament.

The time limit is 12 minutes per player per game.

PRIZES

- ★ Trophies awarded to top scoring players: 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th.
- ★ Trophies awarded to top 3 placed schools in each division.
- ★ All participants receive an electronic certificate of participation.
- ★ The top 3 schools from each division qualify for the Regional Semi-Finals, held in Term 3.
