Teams must arrive by 9:30am, so the first round can start at 10am.
- Eligibility:** Teams consist of **three** players. There will be two divisions:
- Primary Schools Division
 - Secondary Schools Division
- Format:** The tournament will be a **7-round Swiss**. Games will be played under the official rules of chess - *touch move and touch take* apply. Participants will use a chess clock with a time limit of 15 minutes per player for the whole game. Instruction on the use of chess clocks will be given on the day.
- Lunch:** There will be a canteen provided with food and drinks available for purchase, including a sausage sizzle, sandwiches and snacks.
- Entry Fee:** \$66 per team (GST inclusive).
Sydney Academy of Chess will invoice the school for the appropriate number of teams entered.
